

# DEVELOPING COMMUNITY, CAPACITY AND SPIRIT 2:

## THE HOW

This workshop explores community development practice - **the how** - in more depth. It builds on the frameworks introduced in 'Developing Community, Capacity and Spirit: The What and the Why', and supports participants in applying these to their work. Through interaction, dialogue, and some additional frameworks we will explore keys to successful community development, as well as the common pitfalls.

### ALONG THE WAY WE MAY CONFRONT SOME OF THE DIFFICULT QUESTIONS LIKE:

- "What do we do about the fact that the same old people keep turning up to meetings?"
- "How do we avoid burnout in ourselves or others?"
- "How do we build genuine energy, enthusiasm, spirit and leadership amongst community members?"
- "How do we build effective relationships between agency workers and local residents?"
- "What might departments and agencies be doing that diminishes community, or community spirit, and what can we do that enhances them?"

*Please note that Module 1 ("The What and the Why") - or equivalent CSD training from previous years - is a prerequisite for this course.*

*This course is relevant to anyone wanting to develop their understanding of community development and related work. This could include **managers, policy makers, community and human services workers, volunteers and community members.***

*Ideally, this workshop is build around the real life experiences and challenges of participants. So please give some thought to elements of your work that you'd like to explore.*
